North-South information flows


- Information as a resource for development

 - Potential of the Open Access movement




- Schemes to assist in gaining access to literature

Unintended consequences


- Disappointing usage

South-North & South-South information flows




South-North information flows

- Small relative to North-South
- Neglect & exploitation
- Forms of information flow
 - Scholarly information
 - Purchase of publications
 - Archives & MS resources
 - Indigenous knowledge
 - Research data
 - Brain drain

Scholarly content

- Contributions by African scholars & scientists to international literature
- A trickle, why?
 - Quality standards of international journals
 - Prejudice
 - Perception of relevance
 - Poor language skills (English)
 - Poor resources; out of date (N-S flow)
 - Local journals unsatisfactory
 - Poor coverage in indexing & abstracting databases




South-South information flows

- Barriers
 - Dependence on former colonial powers
 - Dominance of western science & scholarship
 - Own work undervalued
 - Dependence on databases
 - Communication links
 - Linguistic barriers
- Internet, e-journals & open access offer hope
